### Dress Rehearsal Details:

Performers should have hair, makeup and costume 100% done for the dress rehearsal. This is essential so we can make sure costumes look just right and hairpieces are well attached. You can dress in the bathroom at the venue but be sure you have everything and get done in time to go on stage. I personally suggest getting ready at home, or at least doing hair and makeup at home and putting on the costume at the venue if it is uncomfortable to wear in the car. If performers aren't 100% ready for rehearsal your photos and pictures of the rehearsal will not be right! You should **arrive 20 minutes prior to the time listed** above. The time above is when the class will be on the stage to rehearse. We will not wait for anyone, we will not go back over it, and we will not wait for students to walk from the back of the venue to the stage if you are just coming in the venue at the last minute.

When you arrive simply come inside and take a seat. We will call the class up to the stage over the PA system.

After rehearsal, all students will go to the photographer's station for a class photo and individual pictures. This is open to everyone with zero fee. Your pictures will be available online a few weeks after the show.

You can video and photograph the dress rehearsal fairly close to the stage so have fun with that!

We will NOT allow video during the actual show for everyone's comfort.

Do not bring an entourage of people to dress rehearsal. You will need to exit the venue after photos because 1) the show is general admission and 2) we cannot have a loud large crowd of people sitting in the venue while students are rehearsing. You may not reserve seats during rehearsal. Any items left on seats will be removed. I suggest that 1 responsible adult brings the performer to the rehearsal and then you have the rest of the family and guests come for the actual show separately. Or you may all come as a group the rehearsal but plan a fun quick activity if time allows between the rehearsal and show (the harbor is very close to stroll around as well as lots of places to grab snacks). The venue security will be completely clearing the venue before doors open. No exceptions.
